**PUBLIC HEARING**

**RESOLUTION NO. 896, A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF SATELLITE BEACH, BREVARD COUNTY, FLORIDA, IMPOSING AN ANNUAL STORMWATER UTILITY ASSESSMENT FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING OCTOBER 1, 2010, AGAINST ALL REAL PROPERTY WITHIN THE CITY LIMITS OF SATELLITE BEACH, BREVARD COUNTY, FLORIDA; PROVIDING FOR CLASSIFICATIONS OF PROPERTY; PROVIDING FOR CERTIFICATION OF ANNUAL STORMWATER UTILITY ASSESSMENT ROLL; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE**

City Manager Michael Crotty read Resolution No. 896 by title.

Mayor Ferrante opened the public hearing on Resolution No. 896.

City Manager Michael Crotty stated that Resolution No. 896 establishes the stormwater utility assessment for the fiscal year beginning October 1, 2010. The fee is \$65.00 a year for a single-family unit, the same as last year. This rate will provide financing for the anticipated stormwater projects during 10/11; however, it does not fully fund the stormwater projects.

Mayor Ferrante asked for public comments; there were no comments.
