

## RESOLUTION NO. 964

### A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF SATELLITE BEACH, BREVARD COUNTY, FLORIDA, ESTABLISHING POLICIES AND FEES FOR USE OF SATELLITE BEACH RECREATION FACILITIES; REPEALING RESOLUTION 941; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE

**WHEREAS**, Resolution No. 941 governs policies and fees for Satellite Beach recreation facilities, and those policies and fees need to be updated.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the City Council for the City of Satellite Beach, Brevard County, Florida, as follows:

**SECTION 1.** Resolution No. 941 is hereby repealed.

**SECTION 2.** The following policies and fees are established for City recreation facilities.

#### **PART 1. OBJECTIVES**

1. Enhance recreation programs for Satellite Beach residents.
2. Encourage joint use of School District, County, City, and military recreation facilities in the area.
3. Provide a more-equitable basis for maintenance and operation of recreation facilities in the City.
4. Provide programs desired by Satellite Beach residents and encourage non-resident participation to make certain programs feasible.
5. Foster cooperation, encourage joint programs, and create reciprocal agreements with adjacent communities, schools, and local governments to enhance recreation for Satellite Beach residents.

#### **PART 2. GENERALLY**

##### **Permission To Use City Facilities:**

1. Shall not constitute City endorsement of the user's policies or beliefs. All press releases, publicity, or advertisements relating to any activity held in a City facility shall clearly state the name of the sponsor and shall not imply that the activity is sponsored by the City unless the City has agreed to co-sponsorship.
2. Shall be denied to any entity fundraising or charging admission unless prior permission has been granted by the City Manager.
3. Shall be denied for religious services or Sunday School, but church-affiliated groups may reserve the facilities for social or recreational purposes.

**Preemption.** The reservation of any facility may be preempted if needed for a City function.

**Security Deposit.** Except for users with standing reservations, a \$100 security deposit shall be required for use of the Civic Center, David R. Schechter Community Center, Pelican Beach Park Clubhouse and pavilions, and athletic fields.

##### **Storage Fees (Annual).**

- \$18 per cabinet; \$60 per large storage area (closet, etc.); \$60 per athletic area.

**Fee Exemptions.**

The following shall be exempt from all fees except the security deposit and storage fees, if applicable:

- Activities sponsored by public schools between the Pineda and Eau Gallie Causeways at the Civic Center on any day, or at Pelican Beach Park pavilions Monday through Friday.
- Standing reservations by military veterans organizations.
- Other exemptions granted by the City Manager which are not religiously, politically, or commercially oriented.

**Advance Payment.**

- Fees shall be paid in advance, according to deadlines established by the Recreation Director. If paid by check, fees shall be paid at least 30 days before the reserved date.
- For teams using the gymnasium or athletic fields, the athletic associations or travel teams, as applicable, shall collect the fees and pay the City at the beginning of each season.

**Standing Reservations** (i.e., repeat reservations for a specific time).

- Scheduling. Between September 1 through 30, the Recreation Department shall receive written application from community organizations which desire standing reservations for the Civic Center, David R. Schechter Community Center, or Pelican Beach Park Clubhouse in the next calendar year. Standing reservations shall not be approved for dates beyond the next calendar year. Where two or more organizations want to reserve the same time, priority shall be given to the group with the most Satellite Beach residents.
- Billing. The Recreation Department shall bill organizations twice annually, once for each of the following periods: (1) January 1 through June 30, and (2) July 1 through December 31.

**Cancellation Refunds.** Refunds shall be given for cancellations requested at least 30 days before the reserved date for all facilities except Pelican Beach Park pavilions, which shall require a minimum notice of three full business days. No credit shall be given for partial use of a reserved period.

**Alcoholic Beverages.** The consumption of alcoholic beverages at City facilities is governed by Section 6-1 of the Satellite Beach City Code.

**PART 3. DAVID R. SCHECHTER COMMUNITY CENTER**

**Fees.**

- **Meeting Room** \$14.50 per hour; \$180 per day
- **Dance Studios** \$10 per hour; \$120 per day
- **Viewing Room** \$ 6 per hour
- **Concession** \$10 per hour; \$120 per day
- **Game Room** \$10 per hour; \$120 per day
- **Concession & Game Room** \$18 per hour; \$216 per day
- **Open Game Room** School Year Monday – Friday: no charge for individuals  
Summer Programs:
  - \$1.25 per child per day
  - \$30 per child for full summer
- **Gymnasium** \$35 per hour  
City Athletic Associations: \$4 per player per season.
- **Open Gymnasium** \$1.50 per person per day  
Annual Memberships: \$30 per individual; \$60 per family

**PART 4. CIVIC CENTER**

**User Categories.**

- Category A: Any community organization with at least 15 Satellite Beach residents.
- Category B: Any community organization with fewer than 15 Satellite Beach residents.
- Category C: All others.

**Fees.**

**PART 5. PELICAN BEACH PARK**

**Clubhouse.**

- **Fees.**
  - Monday-Thursday up to 6 pm \$18 per hour
  - Monday-Thursday 6 pm to 1 am \$150 per session
  - Friday up to 4 pm \$18 per hour
  - Friday 4 pm to 1 am \$250 per session
  - Saturday, Sunday, holidays 8 am to 1 am \$350 per session

**Pavilions.**

- **Hours.** 9 am to dusk, 7 days per week. Pavilions must be cleaned up and vacated by dusk.

- **Fees.**

**PART 6. DOG PARK**

**Fees.**

- Single Visit:
  - \$2.50 for up to 2 people with 3 dogs
  - \$3.50 for more than 2 people or more than 3 dogs
- Pass: \$24 for 12 visits
- Memberships (annual):
  - \$180 per individual; \$120 if all dogs are spayed/neutered
  - \$240 per family; \$180 if all dogs are spayed/neutered

**PART 7. SKATEPARK**

**Hours.** As determined by the Recreation Director; however, the park shall not be open after 10 p.m.

**Fees.**

- Single Visit:
  - \$2 per skater
  - \$1.25 per beginning skater during designated beginning-skate sessions
- Pass: \$25 for 20 visits
- Memberships (semi-annual):
  - \$96 per individual
  - \$150 per family
- Memberships (annual):
  - \$180 per individual
  - \$300 per family

**PART 8. DESOTO PARK****Tennis Courts.**

- **Fees.**
  - Single Visit:
    - Residents: \$2.25 per hour
    - Non-residents: \$3.25 per hour
  - Student Tennis Teams (not associated with schools in City): \$2 per court per day
  - Memberships (semi-annual):
    - Residents: \$50 per individual  
\$90 per family
    - Non-residents: \$100 per individual  
\$150 per family
  - Memberships (annual):
    - Residents: \$100 per individual  
\$180 per family
    - Non-residents: \$200 per individual  
\$300 per family

*NOTE: Membership fees do not cover program or league fees.*

**Racquetball Courts.**

- **Fees.**
  - Single Visit:
    - Residents: \$2.25 per hour
    - Non-residents: \$3.25 per hour
  - Memberships (annual):
    - Residents: \$36 per individual  
\$72 per family
    - Non-residents: \$60 per individual  
\$96 per family

*NOTE: Membership fees do not cover program or league fees.*

**PART 9. ATHLETIC FIELDS**

**Baseball and Softball.**

- **Priority:** Beachside Little League, then other teams as approved by the Recreation Director.
  - **Fees.**
    - City Athletic Associations: \$4 per player per season
    - Single Visit:
      - Daytime (up to 6 pm): \$24 per hour
      - Nighttime (after 6 pm): \$35 per hour
    - Travel Teams: \$500 per team per season
- NOTE: Does not apply to visiting teams for tournaments or league play.*

**Soccer and Football.**

- **Priority:** Teams registered with the Satellite Beach Soccer Club and the South Beaches Youth Football and Cheerleading Association, then other leagues as approved by the Recreation Director.
- **Fees.**
  - City Athletic Associations:
    - Fields without Lights: \$3 per player per season
    - Fields with Lights: \$4 per player per season
  - Single Visit:
    - Daytime (up to 6 pm): \$18 per hour
    - Nighttime (after 6 pm): \$35 per hour

**SECTION 3.** All resolutions or parts of resolutions in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
