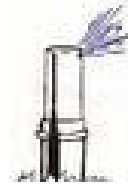


Irrigation Restrictions

The Governing Board of the St. Johns River Water Management District -- which is a state agency -- adopted more stringent irrigation rules in 2008. These rules are effective in our city. Information, including additional rules and a list of exceptions to the rules, is available at the Water Management District website (www.sjrwm.com).



Enforcement of these landscape irrigation rules by the Water Management District has begun in our city. Fines for non-compliance of the irrigation rules are as follows:

First Violation Written Warning

Second Violation \$50.00 fine

- Irrigation is limited to no more than 3/4 inch of water per zone per irrigation day.
- Irrigation is limited to no more than one hour per irrigation zone per irrigation day.
- Irrigation is limited to only that amount necessary to meet landscape needs.
- Persons irrigating with an automatic system installed after May 1991 must utilize a rain sensor device to override the system when adequate rainfall has occurred.
- Irrigation is prohibited between 10 a.m. and 4 p.m.

During Daylight Savings Time (*March 13, 2011 – November 6, 2011*)

- Irrigation is limited to no more than two days per week.
- Residential irrigation at odd numbered addresses or no addresses is allowed on Wednesdays and Saturdays. Residential irrigation at even numbered addresses is allowed on Thursdays and Sundays.

During Eastern Standard Time (*November 6, 2011 – March 11, 2012*)

- Irrigation is limited to no more than one day per week on the scheduled weekend days.
- Residential irrigation at odd numbered addresses or no addresses is allowed on Saturdays. Irrigation at even numbered addresses is allowed on Sundays.
