The City of Satellite Beach received grant funding from the Florida Department of Economic Opportunity to create plans to **revitalize our portion of SR A1A**. Between October and December, the first round of public workshops were held in which approximately **120 people attended** and shared their **thoughts, concerns and ideas**. City staff and consultants have compiled and analyzed the collected information in preparation for the **Plan Development Phase**. We want your input on ideas for this Conceptual Plan!

**To facilitate this, the City will conduct four follow-up workshops, enabling you to:**

- Review information collected during the first round of public meetings.
- Interact with planners, engineers, and City residents and businesses.
- Ask questions and give your ideas!

**As a reminder, the Conceptual Plan will focus on improving commercial properties and pedestrian safety by identifying ways to:**

- Aggregate small commercial properties,
- Share parking and stormwater retention areas for commercial properties, and
- Increase pedestrian sidewalks, crosswalks, and islands for greater pedestrian use and safety.
