

ORDINANCE NO. 1025

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF SATELLITE BEACH, BREVARD COUNTY, FLORIDA, AMENDING THE SATELLITE BEACH PERSONNEL POLICY SECTION 14.03(B)(2) VISION CARE SERVICES; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SATELLITE BEACH, BREVARD COUNTY, FLORIDA as follows:

SECTION 1. Said Policy was adopted by Ordinance No. 435 and amended by Ordinance Nos. 464, 477, 479, 488, 495, 505, 526, 546, 575, 612, 633, 640, 644, 653, 665, 697, 710, 711, 737, 770, 798, 821, 846, 893, 902, 914, 931, 940, 952 and 978, 999, and 1010;

SECTION 2. Section 14.03(B)(2) the Satellite Beach Personnel Policy is hereby amended to read as follows:

**SECTION 14
MISCELLANEOUS RULES AND BENEFITS**

14.03(B) Visions Care Services

1. Full-time employees are eligible for an eye examination once every two (2) years by a certified ophthalmologist or eye care specialist within Brevard County. The City shall reimburse the employee upon presentation of a receipt for such examination.
2. The City will reimburse each full-time employee for the purchase, repair, or replacement of vision correcting appliances and their fitting up to, but not exceeding Two Hundred Twenty-Five Dollars (\$225.00) every two (2) years.

SECTION 3. SEVERABILITY CLAUSE. In the event a court of competent jurisdiction shall hold or determine that any part of this Ordinance is invalid or unconstitutional, the remainder of the Ordinance shall not be affected thereby, and it will be presumed that the City Council for the City of Satellite Beach did not intend to enact such invalid or unconstitutional provision. It shall further be assumed that the City Council would have enacted the remainder of this Ordinance without said invalid and unconstitutional provision, thereby causing said remainder to remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 4. REPEAL OF INCONSISTENT PROVISIONS. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 5. EFFECTIVE DATE. The provisions of this ordinance shall be effective


retroactive to October 1, 2009.
