

ORDINANCE NO. 1111

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF SATELLITE BEACH, BREVARD COUNTY, FLORIDA, AMENDING THE SATELLITE BEACH PERSONNEL POLICY SECTION 12.01 (JOB CLASSIFICATION LEVELS) TO ADD JOB CLASSIFICATION FOR DEPUTY RECREATION DIRECTOR AND SALARY RANGE; TO ADD JOB CLASSIFICATION FOR COMPTROLLER AND SALARY RANGE; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, from time to time the City finds it necessary to amend the City's Personnel Policies; and

WHEREAS, these policies and procedures serve as a guide to the administrative actions concerning personnel activities.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SATELLITE BEACH, FLORIDA as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 12.01 of the Satellite Beach Personnel Policy is hereby amended by adding Pay Grade 24, Deputy Recreation Director, with a pay range of \$40,776 - \$63,611.

SECTION 2. Section 12.01 of the Satellite Beach Personnel Policy is hereby amended by adding Pay Grade 30, Comptroller, with a pay range of \$54,644 - \$85,245.

SECTION 3. SEVERABILITY CLAUSE. In the event a court of competent jurisdiction shall hold or determine that any part of this Ordinance is invalid or unconstitutional, the remainder of the Ordinance shall not be affected thereby and it will be presumed that the City Council for the City of Satellite Beach did not intend to enact such invalid or unconstitutional provision. It shall further be assumed that the City Council would have enacted the remainder of this Ordinance without said invalid and unconstitutional provision thereby causing said remainder to remain in full force and effect.


SECTION 4. REPEAL OF INCONSISTENT PROVISIONS. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 5. EFFECTIVE DATE. This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.

SECTION 6. This Ordinance was duly passed on first reading at a regular meeting of the City Council on the 2nd day September, 2015, and adopted on the second and final reading at a regular meeting of the City Council on the 7th day October, 2015.
