

ORDINANCE NO. 464

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 12 (JOB CLASSIFICATION LEVELS) OF THE PERSONNEL POLICY, SAID POLICY ADOPTED BY ORDINANCE NO. 435; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SATELLITE BEACH, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1. Section 12 of the Satellite Beach Personnel Policy is hereby amended to read as follows:

SECTION 2. Repeal of Inconsistent Provisions. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. Severability. In the event a court of competent jurisdiction shall hold or determine that any part of this ordinance is invalid or unconstitutional, the remainder of the ordinance shall not be affected thereby and it shall be presumed that the City Council did not intend to enact such invalid or unconstitutional provision. It shall further be presumed that the City Council would have enacted the remainder of this ordinance without said invalid or unconstitutional provision.


SECTION 4. Effective Date. This ordinance shall become effective upon its adoption.
