

## ORDINANCE NO. 477

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF SATELLITE BEACH,  
FLORIDA; AMENDING SECTION 12 (JOB  
CLASSIFICATION LEVELS) OF THE PERSONNEL  
POLICY, SAID POLICY ADOPTED BY ORDINANCE  
NO. 435 AND AMENDED BY ORDINANCE NO. 464;  
PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SATELLITE BEACH,  
FLORIDA:

SECTION 1. Section 12 of the Satellite Beach Personnel Policy is  
hereby amended to read as follows:

SECTION 2. Repeal of Inconsistent Provisions. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.


SECTION 3. Severability. In the event a court of competent jurisdiction shall hold or determine that any part of this ordinance is invalid or unconstitutional, the remainder of the ordinance shall not be affected thereby and it shall be presumed that the City Council did not intend to enact such invalid or unconstitutional provision. It shall further be presumed that the City Council would have enacted the remainder of this ordinance without said invalid or unconstitutional provision.

SECTION 4. Effective Date. This ordinance shall become effective upon its adoption.

SECTION 5. This ordinance was duly passed on first reading at a regular meeting of the City Council on the 5th day of October, 1988, and adopted on second and final reading at a regular meeting of the City Council on the 19th day of October, 1988.
