

**SATELLITE BEACH RECREATION BOARD
MINUTES FROM MEETING HELD May 10, 2016**

The meeting of the Satellite Beach Recreation Board was called to order on May 10, 2016 at 6:20pm by Chairman Clint Braswell. Members in attendance were Clint Braswell, Charlie Graham, Mike Hensley, Kelly Palace, Jim Straayer, and Duane Swenson. Also present was Recreation Director Cassie Warthen.

Approval of Minutes: The Minutes from the April 12, 2016 meeting were reviewed. Mike Hensley moved, seconded by Charlie Graham to approve the minutes as presented. All ayes, motion passed.

Update on Cinnamon Park: Cassie discussed the improvements to Cinnamon park, including installation of all the new playground equipment, new fencing and mulch throughout. The grant still includes a picnic table and park bench for the park, which is being ordered from Playmart, and is expected to be installed by the end of the summer.

Discuss/approve proposed improvements to Olson Park, improvements to be included in FRDAP grant Application: Cassie showed pictures of the existing Olson playground equipment, and discussed how public works has been maintaining the small structure for years to keep it safe enough to use. The photos show a good deal of rust on the metal parts from the salty air. The board talked about possible improvements to the playground, in addition to the equipment itself, including renovation of the existing nature trail, adding an exercise trail and picnic facilities. Board agreed to gear the playground to kids a little bit older than those that would use Cinnamon park, which is in close proximity to Olson.

Other Business: The City Council will be hosting several town hall meetings throughout the community and everyone that can make it should attend. The council will be sharing information on Infrastructure Projects, Lagoon Restoration Projects, Amendments to the City's Charter, Community Redevelopment and City finances and Budget. The City has already held one of the five meetings, so there are still four more opportunities to attend.

Satellite Beach Soccer Club has officially changed its name to Brevard Beachside Soccer Club and will be holding a lighting ceremony for the newly installed soccer field lights at the Satellite Beach Sports & Recreation Park on Saturday May 14, 2016 from 7-9pm. All are welcome to attend.
